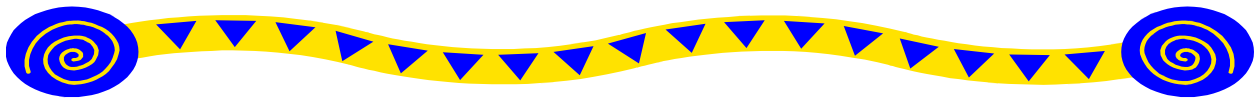

Summer is just around the corner so please have a safe and Happy Summer!!

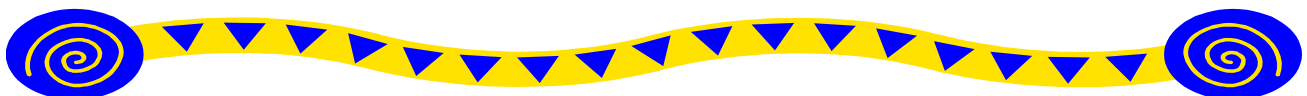


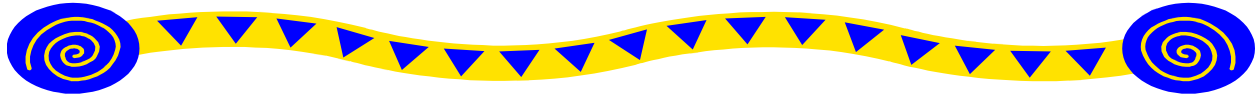

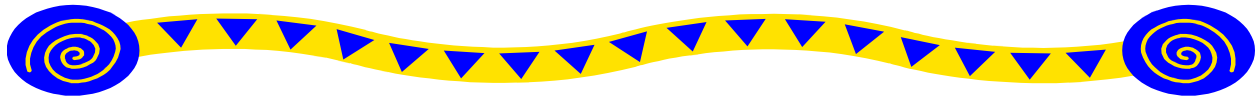
